Dear Parents/Carers.


It has been great to walk around and see our students continue their learning journey. I look forward to our up and coming Parent Teacher Conferences to celebrate their learning progress. Also it is


Who can use the Dental Service?

Adults – You must hold a current Health Care Card or Pension Card and show this card at each visit.

Young people – aged 12 to 18 years of age (in Years 7 to 12) who hold, or whose parents hold, a concession card. Families eligible for the Commonwealth Child Dental Benefits Schedule (CDBS) are also able to access dental services through IPC Health (see below for further details).

Preschool and primary school children – All children aged between 2 and 12 years of age. A parent/guardian must be present during consultation.

Members of our Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities will be prioritised.





Please note - if your child is entering our illustration competition, entries are due by the end of Week 8 (next week) to Mrs Langfield, or a member of our Whole School Events team.


















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BREAKFAST CLUB NEWS


They have also begun to create their own personal acknowledgements to include on their pieces.
